As of January 2021, DAI implements 180 projects in 90 countries on behalf of 17 clients. For USAID alone, DAI currently implements 88 projects valued at \$2.7 billion. In 2020, DAI adapted this experience to the COVID-19 context to lead 16 remote start-ups for new USAID projects.

In 2017, the USAID Office of Small and Disadvantaged Business Utilization named DAI its Large Business Partner of the Year.
