DAI is an employee-owned global development firm based in Bethesda, Maryland. For more than 50 years, DAI has provided technical expertise, project management, and consulting services to USAID, the U.S. Government, and dozens of development partners around the world.

As of January 2021, DAI implements 180 projects in 90 countries on behalf of 17 clients. For USAID alone, DAI currently implements 88 projects valued at \$2.7 billion.
